- Credit Card will also be debited for fuel consumption at end of journey
- **Fuel charge: All the consumables (oils, diesel oil, gas...) used during your stay are included in this charge.** When you set off, the tank will be filled, giving you self-sufficiency for your journey. All barges are fitted with a meter which is read on your departure and return. The number of hours of engine fuel used, will be charged to you according to the rate displayed at the base.
  - On average between €30 and €60 per day (subject to fuel price increases)
  - For the Sixto Green (Electric boat) there is a cost of €300 per week
