Overnight: Lake Attersee

Day Three: Lake Attersee to Lake Traunsee, approximately 50 km, boat trip on Lake Traunsee

Tackle a gentle ascent through the Weissenbachtal Valley, rewarded by a thrilling descent to the Traun River. Arrive in Ebensee and enjoy a scenic boat ride on Lake Traunsee, surrounded by towering peaks and charming villages

Overnight: Lake Traunsee

Day Four: Lake Traunsee via Lambach to Linz, approximately 30km by bike, to Linz by train

Cycle along the Traun River to the historic town of Lambach. Board a train to Linz, Upper Austria's vibrant capital. Indulge in a slice of the famed Linzer Torte and explore the city's blend of contemporary art and Baroque architecture.

Overnight: Linz

Day Five: Linz to Grein, approximately 60 km

Pedal through the tranguil Danube meadows, home to rare flora and fauna. Reach the charming town of Grein. Visit Greinburg Castle, housing a fascinating maritime museum, and explore Austria's oldest theatre.

Overnight: Grein

Day Six: Grein to Wachau Valley, approximately 65 km

Navigate the captivating Strudengau region, characterized by its rugged landscapes and forested cliffs. Enter the UNESCO-listed Wachau Valley, celebrated for its terraced vineyards, apricot orchards, and medieval towns.

Overnight: Wachu Valley

Day Seven: Wachu Valley via Tulln to Vienna, approximately 65 km by bike, to Vienna by train

Cycle through picturesque villages like Dürnstein and Weißenkirchen, where time seems to stand still. Visit the impressive Melk Abbey before taking a train from Tulln to Vienna. Upon arrival, immerse yourself in the capital's imperial grandeur and vibrant cultural scene

Day Eight: Depart for Salzburg

Depending on your schedule, explore Vienna's iconic landmarks, such as St. Stephen's Cathedral or the historic Naschmarkt, before bidding farewell to this unforgettable journey.
