Day 1: Arrival in Nauders

Settle into the charming alpine town of Nauders, nestled near the Austrian – Italian border.

You will receive the information documents for your cycling holiday in Italy at the hotel. At the handover point, you will also receive your rented bicycles.

Overnight: Nauders

Day 2: Cycle from Nauders to Schlanders/surrounding, approximately 55-80km

Begin with a gentle ascent to the serene Lake Reschen, renowned for its submerged church tower – a perfect photo opportunity.

Enjoy a rewarding downhill ride through the Venosta Valley, passing historic Marienberg Monastery, continue downhill to Laastsch, Glurns and the picturesque holiday resorts of Schlanders, Naturns or the surrounding area.

Overnight: Schlanders

Day Three: Cycle from Schlanders to Merano, approximately 20 – 40 km

Pedal through expansive apple orchards, with the majestic Alps as your backdrop.

Today's cycle tour along the Adige cycle path takes you to Merano, known for its spas and Art Nouveau buildings.

Overnight: Merano

Day Four: Cycle from Meran to Bolzano, approximately 35 km

Follow the Adige River, passing the confluence of Sigmundskron Castle. Journey through rolling vineyards to reach Bolzano, a city where Italian and Austrian cultures intertwine.

Overnight: Bolzano

Day Five: Cycle from Bolzano to Trento, approximately 65 km

Enjoy cycling along the Adige River to the Salurner Klause, in the village of San Michele all'Adige. Explore the historic city of Trento, known for its Renaissance architecture and vibrant piazzas. This route takes you directly to the centre of the old council town of Trento.

Overnight: Trento

Day Six: Cycle from Trento to Arco/Riva at Lake Garda, approximately 50 km

Ride through charming vineyards to the towns of Rovereto and Mori. After a gentle climb to San Giovanni, descend towards the northern shores of Lake Garda, arriving near Torbole and Arco/Riva.

Overnight: Riva

Day Seven: Conclude your tour in the scenic town of Riva del Garda.

Depart Riva, end of tour.
