Inn Cycle Path The Classic Tour - Innsbruck to Passau







Follow the lovely River Inn cycling in a relaxing pace away from the Tyrolean Mountains, through Upper and Lower Bavaria towards the Upper Austrian Innviertel by the Danube. Mostly flat, partly hilly your cycle route leads through historical cities and picturesque villages: Innsbruck capital of the Tyrol, the fortification in Kufstein and Burghausen, historical trading places and the beautiful baroque town of Obernberg and Schärding as well as the Three River City of Passau.

Availability: 25 April - 10 October

Day 1: Individual arrival in Innsbruck

You will check into your hotel and receive travel documents and rental bikes (if booked). Afterwards, a walk through Innsbruck's old town is recommended – the Golden Roof sparkles, and the inns serve Tyrolean Gröstl with a view of the Nordkette.

Example of hotel: Hotel Rufis in Innsbruck

Day 2: From Innsbruck to Kufstein, approx. 50 km by bike + train ride

Out of the city, into the Tyrolean Inn Valley. You cycle downstream via Hall with its medieval old town and past the sparkling Swarovski Crystal Worlds in Wattens. The train takes you comfortably from Brixlegg to Kufstein - known for its imposing fortress and the famous "Kufsteinlied".

Example of hotel: Arte Hotel in Kufstein

Day 3: From Kufstein to Wasserburg, approx. 65 km

They leave Tyrol behind and roll leisurely into the Bavarian Alpine foothills. On the dam, through alluvial forests and past orchards, it goes to the pearl on the Inn: Wasserburg, picturesquely situated in a river bend, with an onion dome and tavern culture to fall in love with.

Example of hotel: Gasthof Paulanerstuben in Wasserburg

Day 4: From Wasserburg to Mühldorf, approx. 50 km

With rolling hills and small villages, the path leads you through typical Bavarian farmland. Mühldorf welcomes you with its elongated town square, facades with Lüftl paintings and hearty snacks in the beer garden - pretzels and Obazda included.

Example of hotel: Altstadthotel Wetzel in Mühldorf

Day 5: From Mühldorf to Kirchdorf am Inn, approx. 45 km

After a stopover in Altötting, Bavaria's most important place of pilgrimage, you will soon reach the Innviertel in Upper Austria. Culinary delights are now hearty and cozy: Grammelknödel, Innviertler Surspeck and a tasty beer are waiting. The day ends in Kirchdorf am Inn, a border town where tavern tradition is writ large.

Example of hotel: Hotel Inntalhof in Kirchdorf am Inn

Day 6: From Kirchdorf/Inn to Bad Füssing, approx. 35 km

The day begins in the natural jewel of the Lower Inn European Reserve: waterfowl, reed landscapes and wide meadows - a paradise for nature lovers. Then switch back to Bavaria, towards Bad Füssing, one of the most famous health resorts in Europe. Thermal water, massages, music evenings - here well-being becomes part of the daily program.

Example of hotel: Hotel Vier Jahreszeiten in Bad Füssing

Day 7: From Bad Füssing to Passau, approx. 35 km

The last stage shines with baroque pearls: Obernberg am Inn, the Reichersberg Abbey and the colourful "Silberzeile" of Schärding. Finally, you will reach Passau - with three rivers, Italian flair and a cathedral in which the sound of the largest cathedral organ in the world reverberates for a long time.

Day 8: Individual journey home or additional nights

Bookable: Return to Innsbruck by train - or you can stay in Passau for a few more hours of baroque enjoyment
