Salzkammergut Cycle Path Salzburg - Lake district of Salzkammergut







Overview:

A good cycling tour offer combined with genial Austrian hospitality. In Salzburg start and finish exploring the beautiful Lake District of the Salzkammergut. A picturesque landscape, nostalgic flair and delicious specialties will enchant you during this very special bike tour.

Itinerary: Available April- November

Day 1: Arrival in Salzburg

The cycling holiday starts in Salzburg. Once you have checked in, you will receive your document pack with detailed route maps. Enjoy the day at leisure exploring Salzburg. If you have enough time, we recommend a city tour with a visit to Mozart's residential house.

Overnight: Hotel Amedia in Salzburg or similar

Day 2: Cycle from Salzburg to Lake Wolfgangsee (approximately 50 km)

The handover of your rented bike is at Hotel Amedia on the day before your first cycling trip to Salzburg. Continue cycling through Salzburg's Flachgau via Eugendorf to Thalgau along the impressive Drachenwand (dragon wall) before you reach the picturesque Lake Mondsee. Up in Scharfling, a magnificent view opens up towards Lake Wolfgangsee, from where your cycling tour leads down rapidly to lovely St. Gilgen, Mozart's town. Depending on your booked hotel the boat and ferry ride is on the second or third day of your cycle tour.

Overnight: Hotel Carossa in Abersee or similar

Day 3: Lake Wolfgangsee to Lake Traunsee (approximately 40 km)

Today you cycle in direction of Bad Ischi. The emperor village offers a great variety of culture, local and international specialties and history and was the summer residence of Emperor Franz Joseph and many artists. Continue cycling along the River Traun to Ebensee before you continue along Lake Traunsee to Altmunster.

Overnight: Panorama Hotel Traunsteinin Altmunster or similar

Day 4: Lake Traunsee to Lake Attersee (approximately 40 km)

Similar to a fjord Lake Traunsee forces its way through, between Mt. Traunstein and the Höllengebirge range. Cycling to Gmunden, well-known for its ceramics manufactory and Castle Ort we recommend a stroll along the beautiful lake promenade, before you continue through the Aurachtel valley in the direction of Lake Attersee.

Overnight: Hotel Prielbauer in Mondsee or similar

Day 5: Lake Attersee to Lake Mondsee (approximately 35 km)

For today's cycle route follow the turquoise Lake Attersee to Unterach reaching Lake Mondsee after approximately 2 kilometers. Cycling along the north bank to the village of Mondsee, you can visit the pre-historic stilt houses and enjoy some local specialities.

Overnight: Hotel Prielbauer in Mondsee

Day 6: Lake Mondsee to Salzburger Lake District (approximately 45 km)

Today you cycle through the lovely surroundings of Lake Mondsee, past Lake Irrsee, before reaching the Salzburger Lake District. If you like Beer, we recommend a stop at the Trumer Beer Brewery.

Overnight: Hotel-Gasthof Altwirt Seeham

Day 7: Salzburger Lake District to Salzburg (approximately 45 km)

Along the Salzburger Lake tour many lovely spots which are ideal for a stop having a refreshing swim, before you cycle back to Salzburg enjoy a last view onto the magnificent Salzkammergut mountain range.

Overnight: Hotel Amedia in Salzburg

Day 8: Departure

Your cycling holiday comes to an end today, however you can extend your stay please enquire with us.
