Trans Austria Salzburg to Vienna







The musical cycle tour in Austria starts in Salzburg, the city of Mozart. You cycle through the gently undulating lakes of the Salzkammergut Region to Linz on the Danube, the home of Anton Bruckner. Here your lake tour changes into a river bike tour on the Danube cycle path. You follow the cycle path along the Danube through the Strudengau and Wachau regions until you finally reach Vienna, the city of Waltz.

Availability: 28 March - 10 October

Day 1 - Individual arrival in Salzburg

After your individual arrival for your cycling holidays, check-in and you receive your travel documents. The first day of your cycling vacation is perfectly suited for a **city walk following Mozart's footsteps**. You discover places which are steeped in history with Mozart connections: Birthplace, Salzburg Residence, Mozartplatz, Mozarteum Foundation and much more.

Hotel example: Hotel St. Virgil in Salzburg

Day 2 - From Salzburg to the Lake Attersee, approx. 60 km

On the first day of cycling, the bikes are handed out (if you have booked our rental bikes). You leave the Mozart city of Salzburg and cycle in the direction of Wallersee. The cycle path in the Salzkammergut continues along the picturesque shores of Lake Mondsee until you reach Austria's largest inland waterway, Lake Attersee.

Hotel example: Seehotel Post am Attersee

Day 3 - From the Lake Attersee to the Lake Traunsee, approx. 50 km + boat trip

Well fortified from breakfast, you tackle the short ascent into the Weißenbachtal valley. As a reward for your efforts, a rapid descent to the banks of the Traun awaits. The cycle tour in Upper Austria now takes you along the Traun to Ebensee on Lake Traunsee. Take a leisurely boat ride to Gmunden.

Hotel example: Hotel Post in Traunkirchen

Day 4 - From the Lake Traunsee to Linz, approx. 30 km + train ride

Today you follow the riverbanks of River Traun until you reach Lambach, where you take the train to Linz, the ancestral home of Anton Bruckner. Take a tour of discovery through the city, as numerous attractions await you. For example, the powerful **Bruckner organ** in the Old Cathedral awaits visitors. Or the carillon on Linz's main square, which plays Johann Strauss' Kaiserwalzer three months a year.

Hotel example: Hotel Schillerpark in Linz

Day 5 - From Linz to Grein/surroundings, approx. 60 km

The Danube Cycle Path takes you past the idyllic town of Mauthausen. On your cycle tour in Austria, you immerse yourself in the impressive natural landscape of the Danube floodplains. Rare animals and plants have found a safe haven in the floodplains near the Danube cycle path. With a bit of luck, you might spot an animal or two during your cycle tour in Upper Austria.

Hotel example: Hotel Aumühle in Grein

Day 6 - From Grein/surroundings to the Wachau Valley, approx. 65 km

Take your time today to visit the maritime museum at Greinburg Castle. To learn some more about the formerly dangerous danube. Get to know the impressing landscapes during this cycle route and forested rock formations of the Strudengau region.

Hotel example: Hotel-Gasthof Zur Wachau in Mitterarnsdorf


Day 7 - From the Wachau Valley to Vienna, approx. 65 km + train ride

This bike tour through the Wachau Valley, UNESCO world heritage region is truly a cultural firework with popular wine cellars and unique landscapes. Krems has another special Mozart treat in store: the **Köchel Promenade**, which leads through the town in Mozart's footsteps. Immortal melodies by this musical genius accompany you on your tour. On your final bike ride you follow the Danube to Tulln. From there you take the train to Vienna. Your last stop on your cycling tour in Austria.

Hotel example: ARCOTEL Kaiserwasser in Vienna

Day 8 - Individual deparature or extra nights

Return transfer by train to Salzburg (included). **Tip:** We recommend an extra night in Vienna to do justice to Johann Strauss, the King of Waltz. Here, too, a City Walk takes you to selected stops related to this great artist, whose 200th anniversary is celebrated in 2025. Don't miss out on this at the end of your musical cycle tour in Austria.
